Connection to the Bujinkan

Hatsumi Masaaki the current Soke of the Bujinkan was during the 1950's a senior student of Ueno Takashi. Both Hatsumi and Ueno were students of Takamatsu sensei. Hatsumi is also a Soke of Koto Ryu Koppojutsu. It was mentioned that Hatsumi was better at the Shuriken and Teppan from Koto Ryu and he received this while Ueno did not.
